

MidOhio.Net Dial-Up Access Settings Windows 2000 Professional

1. Double click on the "My Computer" icon.
2. Double click on the "Control Panel" icon.
3. Double click on the "Network and Dial-up Connections" icon.
4. Double click on the "Make New Connection" icon.
5. Mark **"Dial-up to private network"**
6. Click "Next."
7. Check the box beside the modem that you will be using to connect.
8. Click "Next."
9. Enter the "Area code" and "Telephone number" from the following table.

10. Click "Next."
11. Mark **"For all users"**
12. Click "Next."
13. Enter **"MidOhio.Net"** in the connection name field, and check the box beside **"Add a shortcut to my desktop"**
14. Click "Finish."
15. Right click on the "MidOhio.Net" icon and select "Properties" from the command window.
16. Select the "Networking" tab.
17. Check the boxes beside "Internet Protocol (TCP/IP)" & "Client For Microsoft Networks"
18. Select/Highlight "Internet Protocol (TCP/IP)" and click the "Properties" button.
19. Mark **"Obtain an IP address automatically"**
20. Mark **"Use the following DNS server addresses"**
21. Enter the "Primary DNS server" address **209.190.102.2** and the "Alternate DNS server" address **209.190.102.9**
22. Click "OK" twice.
23. Double click on the "MidOhio.Net" icon.
24. Enter your "User name" and "Password."
25. Click on the "Dial" button.
