

MidOhio.Net Dial-Up Access Settings Windows ME (Millennium Edition)

1. Double click on the "My Computer" icon.
2. Double click on the "Control Panel" icon.
3. Double click on the "Dial-Up Networking" icon.
4. If this is the first time you have opened "Dial-Up Networking," the "Make New Connection" wizard will automatically begin. If this is not the first time you have opened "Dial-Up Networking," double click on the "Make New Connection" icon.
5. Overtyping "My Connection" with **"MidOhio.Net"** Click "Next."
6. Click "Next."
7. Enter the "Area code" and "Telephone number" from the following table.

8. Click "Next."
9. Click "Finish."
10. Right click on the "MidOhio.Net" icon and select "Create Shortcut" from the command window. If a shortcut message opens, click "Yes."
11. Right click on the "MidOhio.Net" icon again and select "Properties" from the command window.
12. Select the "Security" tab.
13. Under "Authentication" enter your "User name" and "Password."
14. Select the "Networking" tab.
15. Click on the "TCP/IP Settings" button.
16. Mark **"Specify name server addresses"**
17. Enter the Primary DNS address **209.190.102.2** and the Secondary DNS address **209.190.102.9**
18. Click "OK" twice.
19. Double click on the MidOhio.Net icon.
20. Click "Connect."
