

MidOhio.Net Dial-Up Access Settings Windows XP

1. Click on the "Start" button. Select "My Computer."
2. Select "Change a setting" from the list on the left.
3. Select "Switch to a classic view" from the list on the left.
4. Double click on the "Network Connections" icon.
5. Select "Create a new connection" from the "Network Tasks" list on the left.
6. The "New Connection Wizard" will begin. Click "Next."
7. Select "Connect to the Internet."
8. Click "Next."
9. Select "Set up my connection manually."
10. Click "Next."
11. Select "Connect using a dial-up modem."
12. Click "Next."
13. In the "ISP Name" field type "MidOhio.Net"
14. Click "Next."
15. Enter the Telephone Number from the following table in the "Phone number" field.

16. Click "Next."
17. Enter your "User name."
18. Enter your "Password."
19. Re-enter your password in the "Confirm Password" field.
20. Click "Next."
21. Check the box beside "Add a shortcut to this connection to my desktop."
22. Click "Finish."

23. A "Connect MidOhio.Net" window will open. Click on the "Properties" button.
24. Select the "Networking" tab.
25. Double click on the "Internet Protocol (TCP/IP)" item.
26. Mark **"Use the following DNS server addresses"**
27. Type **209.190.102.2** in the "Preferred DNS Server" field.
28. Type **209.190.102.9** in the "Alternate DNS Server" field.
29. Click "OK" twice.
30. Click on the "Dial" button.
